ACCOMMODATION EXAMPLES:

- Extended time for tests/quizzes
- Alternate testing/quiz environment
- Tests read/text to speech
- Note taking accommodations
- Seating accommodations
- Alternate textbook formats
- Captioned videos
- Large print
- Interpreter/CART services
- Service & emotional support animals

How to apply:

- 1. Complete the Intake Form
- 2. Read and sign the Release of Information Form
- 3. Share one or more of the following:
 - a. Your most recent IEP/504

 Plan and school-based

 evaluation
 - b. OAA's disability specific form completed by certified provider
 - c. Report from your certified provider

Then we will schedule a time to meet to discuss your accommodation request and next steps.

Students are encouraged to use selfadvocacy skills to initiate the process as early as possible after being admitted to the university. Additional documentation may be necessary. Some accommodation requests require supplementary information and follow up.
