Are you new to your AOD prevention role and could use some help on where to start? Have you been in your position for a while and aren't sure what to do next? Schedule a consultation visit with IHEC.

The purpose of an IHEC Consultation Visit is for campuses to enhance or strengthen their current programming, provide data to justify need for future programming, and to ensure compliance with state and federal regulations.

You can expect a series of brief meetings with key staff and administrators that are scheduled throughout the day. As a result of these interviews we find the common emerging themes and analyze our data to create a comprehensive report that becomes the sole property of the institution.


