GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIPS IN MUSIC 2025-2026

DEGREES:	EIU offers a Master of Arts in Music with the following Concentrations: Performance (Instrumental, Vocal, Keyboard); Conducting (Choral, Orchestral, and Wind); and Composition. STIPEND:	Currently <i>\$1097</i> per month for nine months, renewable for one year, with a tuition waiver for 9-16 credit hours per semester (Fall & Spring).
QUALIFICATIONS:	Completion of an undergraduate degree in music or its equivalent is required. Candidates must be accepted into the University as well as the Department of Music in order to be considered for an assistantship.
UNIVERSITY AND COMMUNITY:	Eastern Illinois University places priority on teaching excellence for a student body in a residential setting. The University is located in east central Illinois and combines the benefits of a community of 20,000 with access to several cities, including Chicago, St. Louis, and Indianapolis.
