ENROLLMENT CHECK LIST:

FIRST THINGS FIRST

- Pay your New Student Enrollment Deposit (\$150). Payment is due by May 1 for summer and fall admits, and Dec. 1 for spring admits. *Transfer students are not required to pay this deposit.
- Visit campus and attend #FUTUREPANTHER Admitted Student Day or any #FUTUREPANTHER Friday. Register for the dates that work for you through your MyEIU account.

APPLY FOR HOUSING

- Submit your housing application and a \$50 non-refundable fee to establish a priority date for room assignment.
 - (Recommended by March 1 for fall/summer admits and Nov. 1 for spring admits.)
- Omplete your room and board contract and housing preference form.
- Pay your \$250 housing down payment
 (By June 12 for fall/summer admits, and Dec. 12 for spring admits.)

APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

- Create a new user ID and password at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
 Note: for previous users, the user ID and password now replace
 the federal student aid PIN.
- File your FAFSA online at www.fafsa.ed.gov as soon as possible after January 1. The recommended FAFSA filling deadline is February 15. Be sure to include Eastern's federal school code: 001674.
- Check the status of your financial aid through MyEIU or PAWS.

PAWS is accessible on your smartphone or tablet. Users can access award status through EIU's mobile site at m.eiu.edu. Click on the green dollar sign.

SIGN UP FOR ORIENTATION THROUGH NEW STUDENT PROGRAMS

FRESHMEN:

- Enrolling in fall: Sign-up opens March 1, schedule your program by mid-May.
- Enrolling in spring: Sign-up opens Oct. 1, schedule your program by mid-Dec.
- Enrolling in summer: Sign-up opens March 1, schedule your program by May.
- Submit your final high school transcript showing date of graduation. If you have dual credit, submit official college transcript.

TRANSFER STUDENTS:

- Enrolling in fall: Sign-up opens Feb. 1, schedule your program by May.
- Enrolling in spring: Sign-up opens Oct. 1, schedule your program by mid-Nov.
- Enrolling in summer: Sign-up opens Feb. 1, schedule your program by April.
- Submit your final college transcript showing all coursework completed, including dual credit. Also, submit your final high school transcript showing date of graduation.
