This spring, the Fifth Grade Art Explorations Program will focus on themes presented in The Way We Were. The program combines a tour and studio experience and is offered free of charge to fifth grade classes in our eight county service area. Over a two-hour visit, students tour an exhibition, are exposed to new vocabulary and concepts, and create an original artwork using challenging techniques and materials.
