- + **SPANISH MINOR:** Take 4 elective courses relating to Latin America. Two of the four courses need to be taken outside our Department (for example, in History, Geography, or Sociology).
- + STUDY ABROAD: Perfect your Spanish and earn language credits! Go with faculty to Mexico over Spring Break and earn 2 credits. Study in Costa Rica in summer and earn 4-6 credits. Spend a full semester (12-16 credits) at our partner schools in Salamanca or Malaga or Sevilla, Spain, or in San Jose, Costa Rica. Study in Ecuador or Argentina and immerse yourself in Spanish!
