TRANSFER AUTOMATIC MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

Must have at least 15 credit hours transferred from an accredited college or university.

TIER ONE

GPA: 3.5 - 4.0 - \$5,000*

(\$2,500 awarded annually)

TIER TWO

GPA: 3.0 - 3.49 - \$3,000*

(\$1,500 awarded annually)

*Renewable up to 4 consecutive semesters if renewal criteria is met.

SUCCESS & ENGAGEMENT AWARD

Students who do not meet the above GPA requirements, but showcase leadership and involvement - **\$4,000**

(\$1,000 awarded annually)



PHI THETA KAPPA

GPA: MINIMUM 3.5 - \$1,000

(\$1,000 one-time award)

- Fall admissions only
- Associate degree required
- Application deadline is March 15

AIM HIGH FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

Students who have an immediate family member who graduated from Eastern Illinois University - **\$1,000** (renewable)

GPA Requirement: 2.8



PANTHER PROMISE TUITION WAIVER

Students from households with an annual income ranging from:

\$55,000 TO \$100,000 WILL RECEIVE UP TO \$2,500 towards tuition for up to eight semesters.

EIU PROMISE PROGRAM

EIU will reduce the cost of your remaining tuition and required fees to \$0 if you meet the following criteria:

- **YOUR FAMILY'S ANNUAL INCOME IS \$66,000 OR LESS**
- You have a minimum of a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- You are an Illinois resident
- You have your financial aid packaged and complete by June 1
- You meet all other AIM HIGH Grant requirements

DON'T FORGET YOUR FAFSA!

Students should complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as possible after it opens.

If you're an Illinois resident who isn't otherwise eligible for federal financial aid, you can submit the Alternative Application for Illinois Financial Aid.

GUARANTEED TUITION RATE

The Guaranteed Tuition Rate Program ensures your first-year tuition rate at EIU will remain the same for four continuous academic years. Even if tuition costs rise during your time at EIU, yours will not.

PANTHER PLEDGE

The Panther Pledge offers community college students guaranteed admission to Eastern Illinois University to complete their bachelor's degree.

- Guaranteed Admission
- Easy Transfer Planning
- Early Connection to EIU

TRANSFER CREDIT

- Eastern accepts all college-level transfer credit with the exception of remedial, developmental, or orientation courses
- Elective credit will be awarded and applied to total hours toward graduation if there is no equivalency to a course at Eastern.
- Out of state credit will be accepted and compared to course offerings at EIU. Providing syllabi and course descriptions will assist in the course evaluation.
- EIU is a participant in the Transferology system (transferology.com/state/il?all), a free online resource where you can find out how your courses transfer.
- EIU is a full participant in the Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI): itransfer.org.
- EIU accepts credit for Nationally Standardized Tests (eiu.edu/registra/apclepcredit.php)
- Students with a baccalaureate-oriented associates degree will be considered a junior with all lower level general education requirements met.
- Students may transfer EIU credits back to their community college to complete an associates degree.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To achieve a baccalaureate degree, students must complete the following requirements:

GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

Students must complete a Senior Seminar, Study Abroad, or Capstone Course and one of the following general education programs:

- Transferable baccalaureate-oriented Associate Degree
- Illinois Articulation Initiative General Education Core Curriculum
- Courses that fit into EIU general education

DEGREE PROGRAM

- Requirements for the major must be met.
- Majors may have specific GPA requirements. Consult catalog for details.

12 SEMESTER HOURS AT EIU IN MAJOR

40 SEMESTER HOURS OF UPPER-DIVISION COURSES

- Courses from a community college or other two-year institution will not count in this total.
- Upper-division courses at Eastern are those numbered 3000 or above.

30 SEMESTER HOURS FROM EIU

- 30 must be taken in the junior and senior years.
- 12 must be taken during the senior year.

120 SEMESTER HOURS CUMULATIVE

- All college-level credit, including electives, count toward these 120 hours.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE

- Successfully complete two semesters in a single foreign language. Students may be exempt from this requirement based on foreign language taken while in high school or at their previous colleges.
 - Two years in a single foreign language in high school with a "C" average
 - Second semester of a single foreign language in college with a passing grade

"C" OR BETTER IN ENGLISH AND SPEECH

- A transferable degree does not exempt a student from this requirement.
- A student receiving a "D" or "F" grade in English or speech will have to repeat the course.

WRITING COMPETENCY REQUIREMENT

Electronic Writing Portfolio

- Submit two papers written in EIU coursework to EWP.

TRANSFER ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS:

24+ SEMESTER HOURS

2.0/4.0 overall; AND 2.0/4.0 from last college attended,

OR

FEWER THAN 24 SEMESTER HOURS

2.0/4.0 overall; AND 2.0/4.0 from last college attended,

AND

meet the following high school admission criteria:

TEST-OPTIONAL: 2.8/4.0 GPA

OR

TEST-REPORTED: 2.5/4.0 GPA AND 960 SAT OR 18 ACT

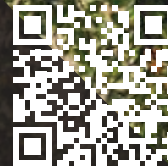
